Humility is God-centeredness

• *Humility* is the fear of the Lord; its wages are riches and honor and life. – Proverbs 22:4

Humility is absence of pride or arrogance

 When pride comes, then comes disgrace, but with humility comes wisdom. – Proverbs 11:2

Humility is willingness to learn

 The way of fools seems right to them, but the wise listen to advice. – Proverbs 12:15

• Blessed are the *poor in spirit*, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven. – Matthew 5:3

• Read Luke 14:7-10
